9.	<p><b>NWTS Update</b></p> <p>Update from Suzy Emsden:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Development of second daytime team is progressing well.</li> <li>- One new consultant started in August, a further two starting in September and October, a consultant returning from maternity leave in November, and have kept one locum on half time basis.</li> <li>- Going into winter should be fully staffed.</li> <li>- Looking at a flexible plan for winter to meet surges.</li> <li>- Looking at how to expand services provided by NWTS to meet the needs of the region (as discussed in item 7).</li> <li>- NWTS are grateful for all feedback received from the DGHs in the region.</li> </ul>	
10.	<p><b>Nurse Group Update</b></p> <p>Updated given by Lucy Allton:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Last meeting took place 19<sup>th</sup> July 2023</li> <li>- Meeting was well attended.</li> <li>- Generally, DGHs have been more steady.</li> <li>- Although still some difficult and challenging patients</li> <li>- Lots of wheezy patients and complex patients</li> <li>- Several EHW patients and safeguarding patients</li> <li>- One site reported a big increase in oncology patients.</li> <li>- Few sudden deaths</li> <li>- Post tonsillectomy bleeds being seen; this is being reported to SiC ODN</li> <li>- Feedback from education days discussed. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>o Introduction to critical care day (8<sup>th</sup> June) aimed at more newly qualified nurses.</li> <li>o Advanced day (5<sup>th</sup> July) aimed at more experienced nurses.</li> <li>o Both days well attended and well evaluated</li> <li>o Pre-learning was given, and then the days themselves were very practical and interactive.</li> <li>o Future events discussed.</li> </ul> </li> <li>- Deputy chairs stepped down, so now looking for expressions of interest to support Lucy and Nicola</li> </ul>	

11. **Updates by area – Reports by exception / Issues with equipment**

Tertiary Centres

AHCH:

- Lot of fatigue due to covering junior doctors strikes.

RMCH:

- Summer period more typical this year
- Finalised winter plan
- Recruitment drive going on to expand PCC staffing; have received funding to increase to 19 PICU beds and 14 HDU beds all year round.

L&SC

Blackpool:

- Nursing staffing challenging
- Recruiting newly qualified nurses, so need to be trained up to support sicker children.
- Influx of EHW patients
- Seeing a lot of RSVS
- Few bad sepsis cases that have had to be transferred out.
- Trialling Aerogene nebulisers

Lancaster & Barrow:

- Looking more like a typical summer so far
- Number of EHW patients has reduced.
- Few transfers out from Lancaster
- Looking at SiPAP/CPAP replacement

Blackburn:

- 2 or 3 HDU patients most days; mixture of reasons
- Have been successful in getting couple of Hamilton ventilators. Will arrange for rep to provide training.

GM

Wigan:

- Few local transfers, but very little HDU activity/tertiary transfers
- Have funding for new Hamilton ventilators.
- Looking at guidance for safe transfers within hospital. Would be grateful for any intrahospital transfer policies that could be shared.

Oldham:

- Summer has been busy, although ok from HDU perspective
- Have developed policy for high flow nasal cannular. It is now to go through ratification process. Aiming to nurse these children on the ward rather than HDU.
- In process of developing inhouse HDU course, to enhance nurse skills.

NMGH:

- June/July busy, but activity now settling down.
- Lots of safeguarding patients
- Several DKA's
- Always have at least one HDU patient, often several.
- In process of developing HDU area. Hope to be in there by winter.
- Have ordered a Hamilton T1, and also a Hamilton C3 from the ODN
- Not seeing high spikes of EHW patients currently
- Doing a review of resus to improve area.
- Seeing a lot of covid, but not much RSV

Stockport:

- Ok at present.
- Few interesting cases, and challenging HDU patients who have been transferred out by NWTS.
- Running second cohort of inhouse HDU course
- Have been allocated a couple of the Hamilton vents and are awaiting training.

Fairfield:

- Have a Hamilton but only for ventilation.
- Putting a business case together for either buying the other settings or for an Armstrong as have no inpatient paediatric beds and moving into winter are mindful that may struggle to transfer patients out via NWAS in a timely manner.
- Currently only have 3 pads nurses. Have just successfully recruited 5 nurses who we plan on educating and upskilling to be able to care for these patients.

C&M

Southport & Ormskirk:

- Summer has been ok so far.
- Several CAHMS and safeguarding patients; have been difficult to manage.
- Lack of communication from social services with parents, which is going to be fed back.
- Seeing increase in oncology and DKA patients
- Running one day HDU courses
- Have lost some senior staff and have a lot of junior staff, so the training will support them.

Whiston:

- Steady flow, manageable
- Few challenging patients; NWTS have been very supportive.
- Few times critical patients
- Busy with EHW patients
- Ward spaces to be reconfigured over next few months.

Warrington:

- Busy with CAMHS and social cases recently
- Staffing issues for nurses, out to recruitment, and then will need upskilling as preceptees.
- No equipment issues at present

Wirral:

- Activity has reduced over summer.
- Seeing children with challenging social issues
- Have a 16-year-old patient with some complex disabilities on adult ICU with a nasty effusion.
- Have a Drager that are going to start using, and have been successful in obtaining one of the Hamiltons
- Noted that it would be useful to know when the SiPAP support ends. Jo McBride will confirm this.

Chester:

- Issues with nursing staff
- Consultant staffing under pressure.
