3	<p><b>Philips Respironics Update</b> <b>Apologies from Katie Farrow</b></p> <p>Anna Hughes updated that we have been informed the next vent due for switchover will be the Trilogy 100, Manchester have informed all patients that this is happening, and will have to organise day admissions for the change.</p>	
4	<p><b>BREAS Ventilator Update – NIPPY 4/4+ and VIVO 3</b></p>	
5	<p><b>ODN Update</b></p> <p>Via email, Joanne McBride:</p> <p>The ODN has completed the education scope meeting:</p> <p><b>Next steps</b></p> <p>Contact WellChild to arrange parents scoping meet. For anyone who is willing to share documents they use so a working group can review what we have in region already Agree working group members and terms of reference. Complete a literature review to see what the evidence says. Look at training standards/ principles and agree a standard for the ODN.</p>	

	<p>Decide whether we need to create regional docs or more likely the ODN supports and endorsed training that already exists and is of a high standard.</p> <p><b>Maintenance</b> Work continues, we are looking at a short term loan library for LTV for urgent needs to prevent admissions- presently being costed. We are also looking at the start up packages, again dependent on dependence and so they align across region.</p> <p><b>Bivona tubes and vent equipment</b> There is a new stratification guideline sent with last minutes. Regional situation improving – taking time.</p> <p><b>Vents / cough assists</b> We are continuing to track delays and reach out for mutual support when needed. Please let Meg and Anna know if you want to escalate issues/shortages.</p> <p>Significant work happening with the hospices and this is planned to continue.</p> <p>Next ODN oversight meeting will be September</p>	
6	<p><b>Advice from Region Tertiary Centres</b> <u>RMCH update</u></p> <p>RMCH have decided to change all patients who are currently on Nippy Juniors to the Nippy 4+ ventilator. This will entail an overnight stay in the hospital, and will require extra training for carers. All families have been informed and the plan is to arrange a training session face to face in RMCH for all carers the first week in September. An email confirming date and time to follow.</p> <p>Lauren Sampson updated from an NIV point of view, there continues to be issues with the humidifier on the VIVO 3, although there has been no update from Breas as to how this is going to be resolved.</p>
