5	<p>Philips Respironics Update</p> <p>Update from Katie Farrow:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Two field safety notices have been circulated re A40 Pro. - One is around vent inoperable status. The percentage of that happening is low; well below 1% failure rate at the moment. - The second one is around the high internal O₂ alarm. - Phillips are working to rectify these issues, and are currently looking at the availability for replacement devices. Katie will keep the group updated. - The tertiary centres are responding to the issues differently. RMCH is swapping out all devices, but this will take some time to achieve. AHCH is carrying out risk assessments, and swapping out devices as necessary. Patients who use their vents over 14 hours a day have been swapped out.
